Wirral's unique combination of coast, countryside and its microclimate, forms the ideal location for high quality produce. Inspired local farmers and producers have created innovative ways for everyone to experience delicious food and drink.

The region is especially known for its excellent asparagus and watercress. At Claremont Farm in Bebington, you will find a superb farm shop selling a range of home-grown produce, including its famous asparagus. Wirral Watercress, recently named as Cheshire's 'Best Food Producer' is also found here, as is Claremont's very own welcoming café and a range of fantastic cookery courses.

Enjoy an afternoon with the family at Church Farm in Thurstaston, with its stunning views across the Dee Estuary to Wales. Choose from their own quality fruit and vegetables, including asparagus and organic produce in the farm shop, relax in the coffee shop, and enjoy fun activities and events throughout the year.

Wirral features excellent markets with delicious produce such as Birkenhead Market, the Wirral Farmers' Market in New Ferry and West Kirby Farmers' Market. There are also several long-established and award-winning butchers in Wirral, including Edge & Son in New Ferry.

Boosting the drinks industry in Wirral are microbreweries like Peerless Brewery, with their range of prize-winning and popular brews sold locally.

Wirral is brimming with quality delis, farm shops and markets. With its breath-taking coastline and picturesque countryside, it is not only a superb dining destination but perfect for that picnic, while soaking up the inspiring surroundings. an era, but the clock was saved, now pride of place in the main entrance at this market.

Birkenhead Market has a spacious indoor market and a traditional outdoor market. Niche trades, local goods and produce ensure a truly Wirral experience, that is diverse and popular. A collectors centre, dance shop, martial arts equipment, reiki specialist and Chinese herbalist are a few of the many stalls woven into the fabric of food, household and clothing shops, providing a unique retail experience other shopping centres cannot match. Farmed by the Pimbley family for four generations, Claremont Farm is the place for innovative fresh food and experiences. Andrew Pimbley is passionate about quality Wirral produce and welcoming visitors to the farm.

The extensive farm shop with fantastic views offers Claremont's home-grown delights, such as their famous asparagus (especially May-June), potatoes, strawberries, brassicas, plus award-winning Wirral Watercress from Childer Thornton

Claremont recently won an Opal award for its 'Asparagus Patch' pop up shop. Andrew says "English asparagus is the best in the world. Here in Wirral the climate and soil are perfect for growing this well-loved vegetable".

In the shop you will find Whieldon's Butchers counter, along with a range of products including bread, cheeses, olives, honey and much more. The shop also has a friendly café so you can sample Claremont's fresh produce here in this beautiful rural setting - what a treat! Whether it is a hearty breakfast, delicious lunch like homemade soup or a tempting cake, whatever you choose will hit the spot.

Look out for a range of food and drink events at Claremont during the year. Claremont Kitchen also hosts cookery courses using produce from the field. You are spoilt for choice with courses such as vegetarian cooking, asparagus evenings, international cooking and bread-making courses.

Farm activities include bush craft days, coarse fishery and free Welly Walks for schools or social groups, which include harvesting produce and wildlife spotting.

Award-winning Birkenhead microbrewery, Peerless, produces craft-brewed beers and lagers, combining traditional techniques with a modern taste.

Creatively named beers include Red Rocks - a strong ruby ale named after the Wirral sandstone point, among others such as Viking Gold, many of which can be found in pubs locally.

Peerless recently scooped five awards at the Society of Independent Brewers (SIBA), including two gold awards for its Knee Buckler golden ale in the strong cask-bitters class, and for speciality cask ale – Jinja Ninja, made with fresh root ginger. The Peerless Pale was also recently hailed as the 'Champion Standard Bitter for the region' at the awards. Bottles of beer can be purchased from the brewery and brewery tours are held on the last Friday of the month.

There is also an open night called 'Thirsty Thursday' on the last Thursday of the month. Check the website for more details.

The farm shop includes a butcher's counter, selling home reared Longhorn beef and Shropshire lamb with other locally sourced meat. At Laycroft there is a full range of local produce including fresh vegetables, pickles, fresh bread, dairy products, pies and cakes.

You will also find a great selection of hampers, wines and products for the home. Finally relax in the small friendly coffee shop. Enjoy a freshly ground coffee, or a leaf tea with a delicious homemade cake or freshly baked cream scone.




